#### Request for Funding (RFF) Application Guidance

The organization applying for funding must be a registered 501(c)(3) who has a program that impacts the residents of Miami County and aligns with the goals of the United Way of Miami County (UWMC). The target goals can be found on our website, on the PDF version of the application. All organizations applying for funding from UWMC must submit, via online submission, only the completed Request for Funding (RFF) application by Friday November 29, 2024. Incomplete, unsigned, handwritten, or in-person submissions will not be accepted. RFFs that deviate from the RFF will not be accepted. While there is a PDF version of the application it is only for your records and review. You will receive confirmation of submission within two (2) business days.

Applications that comply with submission guidelines will be forwarded to the committee for review and scoring using the attached rubric. This is a competitive process, and the submission of an RFF application is not a guarantee of funding. Further, the amount of monetary support offered from UWMC may vary from the amount of support requested. Applications are scored on merit, not historical relationship, and grant awards are based on the availability of funds and demand for funds in addition to the rubric score. Funding through the entirety of the two-year cycle is dependent on the continued availability of funds, timely and accurate reporting by grantees, and compliance with the grant agreement.


